As the Jewish community prepares for Passover, the City of Vaughan will provide the convenient means to dispose of excessive recycling and green bin materials generated in preparation of the holiday. While we urge you to make every effort to use your curbside service, we will also provide a facility at the Garnet A. Williams Community Centre.

Dates:

March 25th to 30th (inclusive)

At the site, we will have three types of bins which will be clearly identified for:

- Food waste/organics
- Recycling
- Garbage

Please note, we will not be accepting any furniture, desks, appliances, drywall etc. This initiative is strictly for household waste and recycling ONLY. Our staff will be on site daily, to monitor the contents of the debris that will be disposed.

It is recommended that residents follow the Greening Vaughan recycling waste management guidelines for the three waste streams. Please note, there are only certain plastics allowed in the blue bin and absolutely no plastic bags are allowed. For more information, please refer to our website at: www.greeningvaughan.ca.
